Submission Guidelines:

- 1. Eligibility: Open to all.
- 2. Photo Format: Digital entries in high-resolution JPEG format.
- 3. Quantity: Each participant can submit up to three photographs.
- 4. Originality: Entries must be original works taken by the participants themselves.
- 5. Image Editing: Basic post-processing adjustments (e.g., cropping, brightness, contrast) are allowed. However, excessive digital manipulation that alters the reality of the scene is discouraged.
- 6. Image Description: Include a brief description (100 -150 words) for each photograph, explaining the concept behind your image.

Judging Criteria:

- 1. Relevance to the Theme: The photographs should effectively convey the concept of "Urban Jungle" by showcasing the interaction between architecture and nature in urban environments.
- 2. Composition and Creativity: Strong composition, use of lighting, and unique perspectives that demonstrate the photographer's creative vision.
- 3. Technical Excellence: Attention to detail, sharpness, color accuracy, and overall technical proficiency.
- 4. Emotional Impact: The ability of the photograph to evoke emotions, tell a story, or provoke thought in the viewer.
- 5. Overall Impression: The judges' subjective evaluation of the photograph's overall quality and its ability to stand out among the entries.

Submission Requirements:

- Each participant can submit up to three photographs.
- Photographs should be accompanied by a short description (100-150 words) explaining the concept behind your image.
